RESULTS AT A GLANCE

MATRIC BOARD EXAM 2016

164 students appeared for the exam and the highest mark 492/500 was scored by Kavya.S. and Faiza Maryam.M. There were 8 centums , each in Mathematics and Science and 16 centums in Social Science, totaling to 32 centums.

Higher Secondary Board Exam 2016

An EXEMPLARY result was achieved in XII Board Exam. 157 students appeared for the exam and achieved centum results. 3 students scored above 1180, 10 students above 1150, 16 students above 1100 and 52 students above 1000. Number of distinctions were 104/157. Bhavani.K. was the topper, scoring 1189/1200, surpassing all the previous records and with centums in Accountancy, commerce, Business Maths and 199/200 in French. She secured District Second Rank and State highest in French. Suganya Rajalakshmi A stood second scoring 1184/1200, with centums in Economics, Business Maths and Commerce. Third Rank was secured by Krishna Patel.N., with a total of 1181/1200 and centums in Commerce and Economics. There were 3 Centums each in Accountancy, Economics, Business Maths, 4 Centums in Commerce and 6 students scored 199/200, the State Highest in French. This result has given new hope of achieving State Rank and the day is not far off!

PROJECTS UNDERTAKEN THIS YEAR



L.D. Classes commenced on 13.06.2016 for the benefit of the children with learning disabilities. Mrs. Kavitha and Mrs.Vijayambiaka have joined hands with Mrs.Umadevi in teaching the students with Learning Disability and they are ably guided by Mrs.Visalakshi Rajagopal, a stalwart in this field.

Similarly, "Early Intervention" classes began with vigor in the new premises, renovated for them. Children in the age group of 0-6 years are given intensive care.

Vidya Vikasini after heralding success in the field of Education over the last four decades, have in recent years embarked on "going green" and "going back to nature". In this direction, apart from setting up a Bio-gas plant last year in V.S.K. Guest Lectures : (Motivation and Career Guidance)



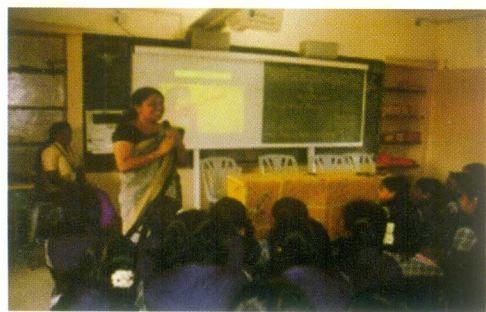
